Hebron is a rural community located in Licking County approximately thirty miles east of Columbus, Ohio.

Lakewood is a consolidated district which encompasses the communities of Hebron, Jacksontown, and Buckeye Lake, as well as sections of Newark and Heath. The district covers an area of 115 square miles.

School

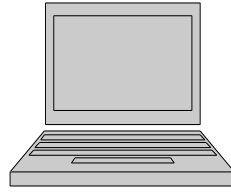
Lakewood Local School District is a school district of approximately 2,182 students. We have one high school, one middle school, one intermediate building and one elementary school.

Lakewood High School is a 4 year (grades 9-12) public, comprehensive high school with an enrollment of:

- Grade 12 - 169
- Grade 11 - 175
- Grade 10 - 161
- Grade 9 - 205

Future Plans

- 48% of graduates plan to attend a four-year college
- 26% plan to attend a two-year college
- 18% plan to enter the workforce
- 4% plan to go into the military



Technology

The Lakewood Local School District has made a commitment to prepare students for the ever-increasing technological world. Lakewood High School has five computer labs with both Mac and PC machines, which is equivalent to one computer for every 7 students. 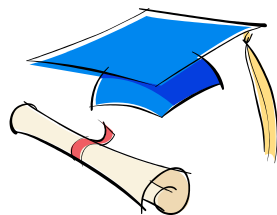

Weighted Classes

Advanced Placement Literature and Composition, Advanced Placement English Language and Composition, and Advanced Placement American History are the only courses that are weighted at Lakewood High School. These courses are designated on a transcript with an (AP). All grades of a C or better in AP are weighted.
